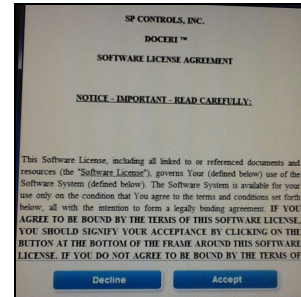


# FREEDOM!! Using Doceri for iPad

1. On **your teacher computer**, double-click the Doceri icon.  
This will get it running.

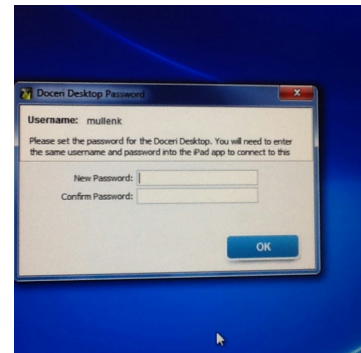
The first time you open Doceri, you will get this:  
Click "Accept"



2. The Doceri Desktop Password box will appear. This is simply a password ***you create*** that you will also enter on your iPad so that both the iPad and your teacher computer can connect. (It's also a little protection so that you won't accidentally connect to another teacher's computer.)

Make it simple. You won't have to remember it after you enter it here and on your iPad.

*NOTE: It may show a different user and only one space for a password. Choose the option to change the password.*



- You *may* get this screen.  
At this point, you don't have to do anything.

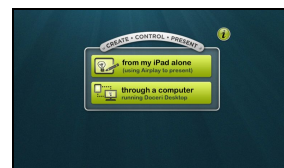
Just proceed to the next step.



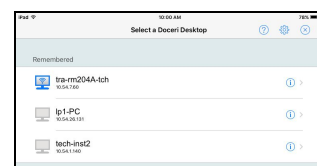
3. On **your iPad**, tap the Doceri app.



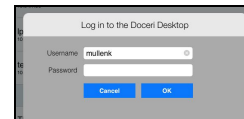
4. Choose the 2nd option: *Through a computer*



5. Your computer name will appear (there may be a list of computers). Choose your computer.



6. Enter your password -- **the same one as in Step 2**. The password will be saved and won't have to be entered again.



7. You will now see this box on your teacher computer, and on your iPad. You are now controlling your teacher computer with your iPad!

You can close this box.

**NOTE:** Doceri simply controls your teacher computer (with the added feature of the draw/whiteboard). So, anything you can do on your teacher computer, you can do using Doceri.

### Doceri Toolbar (on iPad):

- 1 Open a project.
- 2 Record a session or open an already-recorded session
- 3 Open & Close Drawing Mode (press to turn on; press to turn off)

- 5 Quick Launch
- 6 Open & Close Keyboard (press to turn on; press to turn off)
- 7 Settings
- 8 End Doceri Session

### Doceri Draw Toolbar (on iPad):

- 1 Insert a background
- 2 Insert an image (picture)
- 3 Export
- 4 Draw tools
- 5 Redo and Undo
- 6 Erase the entire drawing
