TIP TUESDAY Delete Apps & Extensions

While they're great, sometimes they're too much

Delete Apps:

1. Right-click on the app icon (on a Chromebook, two-finger-tap is a right-click) and choose *Remove* from chrome.

(Note: if "Remove from Chrome" is grayed-out, it is an Enterprise-placedapp —meaning a CCISD Admin-placed-app — and cannot be removed.)

2. Confirm removal by clicking *Remove*.

Delete Extensions:

- In the Chrome browser, in the upper-right corner, click the 3 bars (Ξ) and choose *More Tools* and then *Extensions*.
- 2. A list of the extensions appears. Find the extension to remove. You have two choices:
 - ⇒ Uncheck the box next to "Enabled:" this keeps the extension installed, but it cannot be accessed/used.
 - \Rightarrow Trash can: this deletes it completely.

FYI: Chrome Apps are simply short-cuts to a webpage. Chrome Extensions add functionality to the Chrome web browser.
