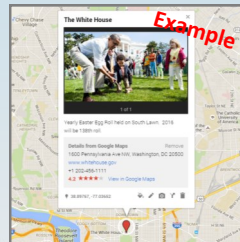
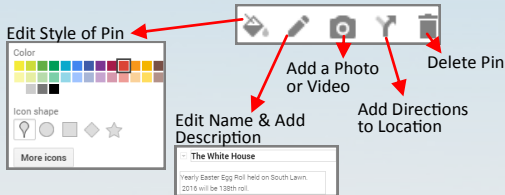


Tip Tuesday

Let Students Create Their Own "Hunt" by Using Google's *My Maps*

This little-known app has many classroom uses!

1. From Google Drive, click *New*, *More*, then *Google My Maps* (or go to www.google.com/mymaps)
2. Click *Create a Map*
3. In the search box in the upper-left, type a location; press *Enter*
4. A "pin" (📍) will drop on the location and information will appear above the pin. If the location is correct, click *Add to map*
5. This brings up edit features:



Examples for student uses:

- 1) Mark birthplace of authors, leaders, scientists, historical figures & add biographical info
- 2) Mark treks taken by characters, explorers, settlers & add trip details
- 3) Calculate distance, speed, time, angles, etc. between locations
- 4) Mark locations of animal species, languages spoken, dialect, measurement systems used
- 5) Share maps with each other and/or teacher for discussion & collaboration
