Just Use Minus!

If you're searching the Internet and notice results that you don't want, simply exclude those items. Here's how:

 A student is researching "cowboys" in a history class. A search for "cowboys" will return many items pertaining to the Dallas Cowboys.





2. To exclude anything with "Dallas," enter "Cowboys –Dallas" in the Google search box



3. The search could be refined even more to "Cowboys –Dallas –Oklahoma –football" to return even better results.
